Fuel Sampling and Testing

Our Service Engineers can undertake routing sampling of stored diesel taking samples from the top, middle and bottom of a fuel tank. It is the first step to being able to detect any water contamination, microbial growth or solid particulate lurking in your tanks.

We can prepare fuel samples that can be analysed using a portable fuel analyser or by or by a third-party laboratory.

For customers with larger bulk fuel tanks we can organise more detailed testing using state of the art equipment and globally recognised methods and standards, which will provide accurate, reliable fuel quality reports and recommend a course of corrective actions if needed.



On-Site Fuel Cleaning

The three main forms of fuel contamination: water, solid particulates and microbial growth (a.k.a. the diesel bug) can be removed from fuel tanks by our on-site fuel cleaning service which is both economical and efficient. We use the fastest and most powerful cleaning rig on the market at 700 l/min, even the dirtiest of fuel can be cleaned in a matter of hours from tanks located at the bottom of a basement to the most sensitive site requiring security clearance.
